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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the Children Services
16 Training Center HVAC Improvement Project, located at 264 S. Arlington St., Akron, Ohio
17 44308, in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$110,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
21 advertise for bids for the aforementioned Children Services Training Center HVAC

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29 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the Children Services
30 Training Center HVAC Improvement Project, located at 264 S. Arlington St., Akron, Ohio
31 44308, in Council District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$110,000.00.

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
37 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned Children Services Training
38 Center HVAC Improvement Project.

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
