7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for HazMat level A**  
8 **and flash suits for the Mahoning and Stark County Type II HazMat Region 5 teams, for an**  
9 **estimated total cost not to exceed \$58,610.70, for the Executive's Department of Law,**  
10 **Insurance and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety-Emergency Management**  
11 **Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for HazMat level A and  
17 flash suits for the Mahoning and Stark County Type II HazMat Region 5 teams, for an estimated  
18 total cost not to exceed \$58,610.70; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;  
21 and

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23 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
25 advertise for bids for the aforementioned HazMat level A and flash suits;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for HazMat level A and flash  
33 suits for Mahoning and Stark County Type II HazMat Region 5 teams, for an estimated total cost  
34 not to exceed \$58,610.70.

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36 SECTION 2

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38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
39 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
40 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned necessary equipment for the  
41 Ohio HazMat Region 5 teams.

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43 SECTION 3

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
