A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of an extension of a professional service contract with Norman R. Johnson, M.D., aka Advanced Correctional Healthcare, Inc. for jail inmate medical services, for a six-month period, from 7/1/17 through 12/31/17, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,021,043.40, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-441, which confirmed an award by the Board of Control of an extension of a professional service contract with Norman R. Johnson, M.D., aka Advanced Correctional Healthcare, Inc. for jail inmate medical services for a six-month period, from 1/1/17 through 6/30/17, for an amount not to exceed \$170,173.90 per month, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,021,043.40; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and Norman R. Johnson, M.D., aka Advanced Correctional Healthcare, Inc. wish to enter into an extension of the aforementioned professional service contract for jail inmate medical services, for an additional six-month period, from 7/1/17 through 12/31/17, for an amount not to exceed \$170,173.90 per month, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,021,043.40; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting on May 10, 2017, awarded an extension of a professional service contract with Norman R. Johnson, M.D., aka Advanced Correctional Healthcare, Inc. for jail inmate medical services, for a six-month period, from 7/1/17 through 12/31/17, for an amount not to exceed \$170,173.90 per month, for a total amount not to exceed \$1,021,043.40, subject to confirmation by County Council; and
