WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-368, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept a Fiscal Year 2016 and 2017 Probation Improvement and Incentive Grant ("PIIG") from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction ("ODRC") for the purpose of assisting probationers in reintegrating into the community, for the period of 7/1/15 through 6/30/17, in the amount of \$169,903.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriated funds;

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas-Adult Probation Department has received Fiscal Year 2017 PHG funds from the ODRC for the purpose of providing programming for probationers in order to assist their successful reintegration into the community, for the period of 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, in the amount of \$29,733.02, which are part of the original \$169,903.00 award;
