7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of professional service**
8 **contracts with certain providers for delinquent care and custody grant services, for the**
9 **period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,801,894.00, for the Court**
10 **of Common Pleas- Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 31, 2017, awarded
13 professional service contracts with certain providers for delinquent care and custody grant
14 services, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,801,894.00,
15 subject to confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, a list of providers is set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that the aforementioned professional service contracts with certain providers are necessary and in
21 the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

28 The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain
29 providers, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution, for delinquent care and custody
30 grant services, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in a total amount not to exceed
31 \$1,801,894.00, is hereby authorized and the County Executive is hereby authorized to executed
32 the aforementioned professional services contracts as set forth in Exhibit A.

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide for delinquent care and custody grant services effective 7/1/17.

42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


