7 **A Resolution determining to proceed with the submission to the voters of the County the**
8 **question of the renewal of an existing tax levy for the programs and services of the Summit**
9 **County Developmental Disabilities Board (the “SCDDB”), and declaring an emergency.**

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

12 SECTION 1

13 This Council makes the following findings and determinations:

- 14 (a) On May 15, 2017, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2017-188 (the
15 “Resolution of Necessity”) declaring the necessity of submitting to the voters of
16 the County the question of a tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the
17 purpose of the renewal of an existing 4.50 mill tax levy (the “Tax Levy”) for the
18 programs and services of the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board
19 (the “SCDDB”).
- 20 (b) The County Fiscal Officer has certified to this Council that the total current tax
21 valuation of the County is \$11,581,228,260 and that the 4.50 mills per each dollar
22 of tax valuation specified in the Resolution of Necessity will generate
23 \$50,570,330 of revenue per year in accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio
24 Revised Code.
- 25 (c) This Council has received the report of the Social Services Advisory Board (the
26 “SSAB”) in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity approving the Tax Levy
27 request and proposal of the SCDDB.
- 28 (d) This Council determines to proceed with the submission of the question of the
29 Tax Levy to the voters of the County at the November 7, 2017 general election.
- 30 (e) All formal actions of this Council relating to the enactment of this Resolution
31 were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this
32 Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions, were in
33 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including
34 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

35 SECTION 2

36 This Council authorizes and directs the Clerk of Council to deliver to the Board of
37 Elections of Summit County a certified copy of this Resolution, a certified copy of the
38 Resolution of Necessity, and the County Fiscal Officer’s certificate no later than August 9, 2017,
39 the 90th day before the November 7, 2017 general election.
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4 SECTION 3

5 The ballot form for this question will be substantially as follows:

10 A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

11 A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Summit County Developmental
12 Disabilities Board for the purpose of providing community developmental
13 disabilities programs and services pursuant to Chapter 5126 of the Revised Code
14 for the benefit of children and adults, at a rate not exceeding 4.50 mills for each
15 one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 45.0 cents for each one hundred dollars
16 of valuation, for a period of six years.

18 SECTION 4

19 This Resolution hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
20 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that this Resolution is
21 required to be immediately effective to submit the question of the Tax Levy to the voters by the
22 deadline for the November 7, 2017 general election.

23 SECTION 5

24 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it will take
25 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it will
26 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

27 SECTION 6


28 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating


