7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections**
9 **services to divert felony offenders from jail, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in an**
10 **amount not to exceed \$1,439,228.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance,**
11 **and Risk Management- Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 14, 2017, awarded a
14 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community
15 corrections services to divert felony offenders from jail, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in
16 an amount not to exceed \$1,439,228.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary and in
20 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
28 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections service to divert felony offenders
29 from jail, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in an amount not to exceed \$1,439,228.00, is
30 hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional
31 service contract.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
37 provide for community corrections services to divert felony offenders from jail effective 7/1/17.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


