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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with US**
8 **SafetyGear, Inc. for HazMat level A and flash suits for Region 5 Hazardous Materials**
9 **Teams, in an amount not to exceed \$51,516.50, Executive's Department of Law, Insurance**
10 **and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety-Emergency Management Agency, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-148, which authorized
14 the County Executive to advertise for HazMat level A and flash suits for Mahoning and Stark
15 County Type II Hazmat Region 5 teams, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$51,516.52;

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18 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 21, 2017, awarded a purchase
19 contract with US SafetyGear, Inc. for HazMat level A and flash suits for Region 5 Hazardous
20 Materials Teams, in an amount not to exceed \$51,516.50, subject to confirmation by County
21 Council; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that the aforementioned purchase contract with US SafetyGear, Inc. is necessary and in the best
25 interest of the County of Summit;

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27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with US SafetyGear, Inc. for
33 HazMat level A and flash suits for Mahoning and Stark County Type II Hazmat Region 5 teams,
34 in an amount not to exceed \$51,516.52, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby
35 authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
40 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
41 provide necessary equipment for the Region 5 Hazardous Materials Teams.

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43 SECTION 3

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
