WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-508, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with CT Consultants Inc. for design and engineering services for the upgrade of Pump Station #6 (Q-183), in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$85,930.00; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to replace rather than upgrade Pump Station #6 (Q-183); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 28, 2017, awarded Change Order No. 1 to said professional service contract with CT Consultants Inc. for the replacement of Pump Station #6 (Q-183), in an amount not to exceed \$127,570.00 (for a cumulative increase of 148.46%), for a total amount not to exceed \$213,500.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to the professional service contract with CT Consultants for Project Q-183 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
