A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc., under CUE pricing, for one 2017 Custom Ford truck with walk-incapabilities, for use in the County Sheriff's Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Task Force Program, in an amount not to exceed \$63,939.67, and adjusting appropriations, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-363, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, through its Ohio Traffic Safety Office, for a countywide Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated ("OVI") Task Force program, for the period 10/1/16 to 9/30/17, in the amount of \$225,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a general encumbrance purchase order for payments to various law enforcement agencies participating in the Task Force, for the period 10/1/16 to 9/30/17, in the amount of \$122,125.07, and appropriated said grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 2, 2017, awarded a purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc., under CUE pricing, for one 2017 Custom Ford truck with walk-in-capabilities, for use in the County Sheriff's OVI Task Force Program, in an amount not to exceed \$63,939.67; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust appropriations in the OVI Task Force budget to purchase said vehicle, including the liquidation and re-appropriation of encumbered funds totaling \$32,649.78 that Council authorized for payments to various law enforcement agencies participating in the OVI Task Force; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit and that it is further necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to adjust appropriations in the OVI Task Force Program budget in the aforementioned manner in order to purchase said vehicle;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
