WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-348, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services of a Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2017 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") grant to the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for Jobs Reentry Program services, for the period 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in the amount of \$115,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriated said grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the actual costs of the Reentry Program are \$125,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Division wishes to use Helping Ohioans Move, Expanding Choice grant funds to make up for the \$10,000.00 shortfall; and

WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that increasing appropriations, in the amount of \$10,000.00, in the FFY 2017 TANF grant for the Reentry Program is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
