WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center to provide case management services for two-parent assistance groups and Summit County Occupational Preparation Experience ("SCOPE") participants in meeting Ohio Works First ("OWF") work participation requirements, for a one-year term, from 10/1/17 through 9/30/18, in an amount not to exceed \$133,110.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for assistance to two-parent households and SCOPE participants in meeting mandated OWF work participation requirements effective 10/1/17.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
