7 **An Ordinance amending Section 169.30 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit, entitled “Travel and Reimbursement,” to comply with federal law by prohibiting**  
9 **reimbursement for identifying or providing temporary care costs for dependents at**  
10 **conferences, for the Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring**  
11 **an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 169.30 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,  
14 entitled “Travel and Reimbursement,” is the County of Summit’s policy for the reimbursement  
15 of travel costs; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, in order to comply with federal law, it is necessary to amend Section 169.03  
18 to prohibit reimbursement for identifying or providing temporary care costs for dependents at  
19 conferences; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Section 169.30 for  
23 the aforementioned reason;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
26 of Ohio, that:

28 SECTION 1

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30 Section 169.30 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled “Travel and  
31 Reimbursement,” is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Ordinance and  
32 incorporated herein as if fully restated.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to  
38 immediately amend 169.30 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to immediately  
39 comply with federal law by prohibiting reimbursement for identifying or providing temporary  
40 care costs for dependents at conferences.

42 SECTION 3

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44 Provided this Ordinance received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.  
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
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SECTION 4
