7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase**
8 **order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails, in an amount not to**
9 **exceed \$80,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, Section 341.12 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the sheriff of a county
12 where there is not adequate jailing capacity or staffing to convey inmates to a jail located in
13 another county; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
16 exempts from competitive bidding contracts with other governmental entities, including those
17 that would contract with the County to house inmates in their jails; and

18
19 WHEREAS, given the nature of the fluidity of inmate boarding needs and related medical
20 services, it is impossible to ascertain how much the County will ultimately spend with each
21 governmental entity, thereby necessitating a super specific purchase order for these items with a
22 total aggregate amount not to exceed \$80,000.00; and

24 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 11, 2017, awarded a super
25 specific purchase order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails, in an amount
26 not to exceed \$80,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council;

28 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
29 of Ohio, that:

31 SECTION 1

33 The award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase order for inmate boarding
34 with other county and municipal, in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00, is hereby confirmed
35 and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said super specific purchase order.

37 SECTION 2

39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
40 welfare of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately allowing the Sheriff
41 to continue boarding inmates in other county and municipal jails.

43 SECTION 3

45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
