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11 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-226, which
12 authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an Ohio
13 Statewide System Reform Program, for the period of 6/1/17 through 1/31/18, in an amount of
14 \$20,000.00, with no local match requirement; and

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16 WHEREAS, the grant period has ended, and it is necessary to appropriate the remaining
17 funds, in the amount of \$8,305.00, for 2018; and

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19 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that appropriating carryover funds, in the amount of \$8,305.00, in the Juvenile Court's Family
21 Drug Court Statewide System Reform Program funds is necessary and in the best interest of the
22 County of Summit;
