7 **A Resolution approving the addition of one Heavy Equipment Operator at the County**
8 **Engineer's Office to the 2018 Report on Staffing, for the Engineer, and declaring an**
9 **emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
12 requires the County Executive to submit annually a report on staffing which sets forth the
13 number of full-time, part-time, and seasonal positions within each job classification, that an
14 office, department, agency, board, or commission may employ during the following calendar
15 year; and

16
17 WHEREAS, Heavy Equipment Operator (# D3704) is a bargaining unit position
18 governed by the collective bargaining agreement with the International Union of Operating
19 Engineers, Local 18; and

20
21 WHEREAS, as part of union negotiations, members requested an additional Heavy
22 Equipment Operator be hired and management agreed to the request; and

23
24 WHEREAS, the bargaining unit agreement was authorized by this Council in Resolution
25 2018-122; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
28 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to add one Heavy Equipment
29 Operator to the 2018 Report on Staffing, bringing the total Heavy Equipment Operator positions
30 to three;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
33 of Ohio, that;

37 The following bargaining unit position is hereby confirmed, and the County Executive is
38 hereby authorized to add said position to the County's 2018 Report on Staffing:

39 **1 – Heavy Equipment Operator, # D3704**

43 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
44 welfare of the citizens of Summit County, and for the further reason that it will allow the County
45 to fulfill obligations agreed to in the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 18
46 Bargaining Unit contract.
