7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement and any other**
8 **documents necessary for an inter-county transfer of funds between the Executive's**
9 **Department of Job and Family Services and four local County Department of Job and**
10 **Family Services, pursuant to which agreement Summit County will transfer a total of**
11 **\$126,600.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

13
14 Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code authorizes counties to execute a
15 JFS 02719 "Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds" to
16 engage in inter-county transfers of funds allocated to county departments of job and family
17 services by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b) provides that a board of county
20 commissioners may assign authority to another party to serve as designee and therefore, grant
21 that party authority to sign an inter-county adjustment agreement on behalf of the county for a
22 specific period of time; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-214, which authorizes
25 the County Executive to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county Agreement and Certification
26 Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section
27 5101:9-6-82 for the acceptance by the County Executive's Department of Job and Family
28 Services ("SCDJFS") of inter-county transfers of funds from other Ohio counties, for the period
29 6/14/17 through 6/30/19, and assigns the County Executive as designee of the County of Summit
30 to execute said agreements and documents as provided in Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b), for the
31 period 6/14/17 through 6/30/19; and

33 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Franklin wish to enter into an
34 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$50,000.00
35 in Federal Fiscal Year 2018 ("FFY18") FAET 50% (Food Assistance Education Training)
36 federal dollars to the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services ("FCDJS"), in
37 exchange for \$50,000.00 of Federal Fiscal Year 2018 Title XX/TANF funds which will fund
38 current year expenditures; and

40 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Madison wish to enter into an
41 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$25,000.00
42 in FFY18 Title XX Base federal dollars to the Madison County Department of Job and Family
43 Services, in exchange for \$50,000.00 of Federal Fiscal Year 2018 Temporary Assistance for
44 Needy Families ("TANF") Administration funds, which will fund current year expenditures; and

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46 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Mahoning wish to enter into an
47 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$50,000.00
48 in FFY18 Title XX Base federal dollars to the Mahoning County Department of Job and Family
49 Services, in exchange for \$50,000.00 of Federal Fiscal Year 2018 Title XX/TANF funds, which
50 will fund current year expenditures; and

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4 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Medina wish to enter into an
5 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$800.00 of
6 FFY18 FAET Participation federal dollars, and \$800.00 of State Fiscal Year FAET Participation
7 State dollars, to the Medina County Department of Job and Family Services; and
8

9 WHEREAS, while Resolution No. 2017-214 authorizes the Executive to accept the
10 transfer of funds to SCDJFS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute an agreement
11 and any other documents necessary for the inter-county transfer of said \$126,600.00 to the four
12 local County's Department of Job and Family Services; and

14 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
15 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
16 Executive to execute the JFS 07219 Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and
17 Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for
18 the transfer of a total of \$126,000.00 in funds to four local County's Department of Job and
19 Family Services;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

24 SECTION 1

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26 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county
27 Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents
28 necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for the transfer by the Summit County Department of
29 Job and Family Services ("SCDJFS") of \$50,000.00 in Federal Fiscal Year 2018 ("FFY18")
30 FAET 50% ("Food Assistance Education Training") federal dollars to the Franklin County
31 Department of Job and Family Services, \$25,000.00 in FFY18 Title XX Base federal dollars to
32 the Madison County Department of Job and Family Services, \$50,000.00 in Title XX Base
33 federal dollars to the Mahoning County Department of Job and Family Services, and \$800.00 of
34 FFY18 FAET Participation federal dollars and \$800.00 of State Fiscal Year 2018 FAET
35 Participation state dollars, to the Medina County Department of Job and Family Services.
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37 SECTION 2

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39 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
40 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
41 authorize the transfer by SCDJS of said funds to Franklin, Madison, Mahoning, and Medina
42 Counties, in order to immediately authorize the funding of current year expenditures.

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
