WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services to make expenditures, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00, for hospitality items incurred in providing training sessions to be held in 2018 and that such expenditures are for a valid public purpose;
