## **SECTION 1**

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Perrin Asphalt Co. for a parking lot improvement project at the Summit County Board of Elections, in an amount not to exceed \$167,275.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such construction contract and any necessary related documents.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately confirm the award of the aforementioned construction contract in order to immediately begin and complete the necessary parking lot improvements prior to the next general election wherein the Board of Elections parking lot will be used for early voting.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
