7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for 75 ruggedized**
8 **tablets with mounting hardware, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$338,000.00, for**
9 **the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of Public**
10 **Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for 75 ruggedized tablets
16 with mounting hardware, to be used by Homeland Security Region 5 law enforcement agencies,
17 for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$338,000.00, funded by Fiscal Year 2016 and 2017 Law
18 Enforcement State Homeland Security Program grants; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;
21 and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
25 advertise for bids for 75 ruggedized tablets with mounting hardware;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that;

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for 75 ruggedized tablets with
33 mounting hardware, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$338,000.00.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
38 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
39 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the ruggedized tablets in order to procure
40 necessary equipment for use by Homeland Security Region 5 law enforcement agencies during
41 the applicable grant performance periods.

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


