7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement and any other**  
8 **documents necessary for an inter-county transfer of funds between the Executive's**  
9 **Department of Job and Family Services and four local County Department of Job and**  
10 **Family Services, pursuant to which agreement Summit County will transfer a total of**  
11 **\$1,169,585.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring**  
12 **an emergency.**

13  
14 Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code authorizes counties to execute a  
15 JFS 02719 "Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds" to  
16 engage in inter-county transfers of funds allocated to county departments of job and family  
17 services by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b) provides that a board of county  
20 commissioners may assign authority to another party to serve as designee and therefore, grant  
21 that party authority to sign an inter-county adjustment agreement on behalf of the county for a  
22 specific period of time; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-214, which authorizes  
25 the County Executive to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county Agreement and Certification  
26 Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section  
27 5101:9-6-82 for the acceptance by the County Executive's Department of Job and Family  
28 Services ("SCDJFS") of inter-county transfers of funds from other Ohio counties, for the period  
29 6/14/17 through 6/30/19, and assigns the County Executive as designee of the County of Summit  
30 to execute said agreements and documents as provided in Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b), for the  
31 period 6/14/17 through 6/30/19; and

33 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Franklin wish to enter into an  
34 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$600,000.00  
35 in Federal Fiscal Year 2018 ("FFY18") regular Temporary Assistance for Needy Families  
36 ("TANF") federal dollars and \$23,400.00 in FFY18 Comprehensive Case Management  
37 Employment Program Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("CCMEP TANF") federal  
38 dollars to the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services ("Franklin CDJFS"), in  
39 exchange for \$600,000.00 of FFY18 Title XX/TANF funds which will fund current year  
40 expenditures; and

42 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Ashtabula wish to enter into an  
43 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$220,000.00  
44 in FFY18 CCMEP TANF federal dollars to the Ashtabula County Department of Job and Family  
45 Services ("Ashtabula CDJFS"), in exchange for \$45,000.00 of FFY18 Title XX funds and  
46 \$175,000.00 of FFY18 Title XX/TANF funds, which will fund current year expenditures; and

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48 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Belmont wish to enter into an  
49 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$50,000.00  
50 in FFY18 Title XX Base federal dollars to the Belmont County Department of Job and Family  
51 Services ("Belmont CDJFS"), in exchange for \$50,000.00 of FFY18 Title XX/TANF funds,  
52 which will fund current year expenditures; and

4 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Perry wish to enter into an  
5 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$276,185.00  
6 of FFY18 CCMEP TANF federal dollars to the Perry County Department of Job and Family  
7 Services ("Perry CDJFS"), in exchange for \$276,185.00 FFY18 Title XX/TANF funds, which  
8 will fund current year expenditures; and

10 WHEREAS, while Resolution No. 2017-214 authorizes the Executive to accept the  
11 transfer of funds to SCDJFS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute an agreement  
12 and any other documents necessary for the inter-county transfer of said \$1,169,585.00 to  
13 Franklin CDJFS, Ashtabula CDJFS, Belmont CDJFS and Perry CDJFS; and  
14

15 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
16 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
17 Executive to execute the JFS 07219 Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and  
18 Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for  
19 the transfer of a total of \$1,169,585.00 in funds to Franklin CDJFS, Ashtabula CDJFS, Belmont  
20 CDJFS and Perry CDJFS;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
23 of Ohio, that:

25 SECTION 1

27 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county  
28 Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents  
29 necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for the transfer by the Summit County Department of  
30 Job and Family Services ("SCDJFS") of \$600,000.00 in Federal Fiscal Year 2018 ("FFY18")  
31 regular Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") federal dollars and \$23,400.00 in  
32 FFY18 Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program Temporary Assistance to  
33 Needy Families ("CCMEP TANF") federal dollars to the Franklin County Department of Job  
34 and Family Services, \$220,000.00 in FFY18 CCMEP TANF federal dollars to the Ashtabula  
35 County Department of Job and Family Services, \$50,000.00 in Title XX Base federal dollars to  
36 the Belmont County Department of Job and Family Services, and \$276,185.00 of FFY18  
37 CCMEP TANF federal dollars to the Perry County Department of Job and Family Services.  
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39 SECTION 2

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41 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
42 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
43 authorize the transfer by SCDJS of said funds to Franklin CDJFS, Ashtabula CDJFS, Belmont  
44 CDJFS and Perry CDJFS, in order to immediately authorize the funding of current year  
45 expenditures.

47 SECTION 3

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49 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
50 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
51 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
