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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1, to a**
8 **professional service contract with Mann Parsons Gray Architect, Inc., for a miscellaneous**
9 **design contract, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 50%),**
10 **for a total amount not to exceed \$60,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**
11 **Administrative Services – Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its August 8, 2018 meeting, awarded Change Order
14 No. 1, to a professional service contract with Mann Parsons Gray Architect, Inc., for a
15 miscellaneous design contract, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00, (for a cumulative increase
16 of 50%), for a total amount not to exceed \$60,000.00,; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with Mann Parsons Gray Architect,
20 Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
21 Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 Change Order No. 1, to a professional service contract with Mann Parsons Gray
29 Architect, Inc., for a miscellaneous design contract, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00, (for
30 a cumulative increase of 50%), for a total amount not to exceed \$60,000.00, is hereby confirmed
31 and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such change order and any necessary
32 related documents.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of
37 the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately confirm the award of
38 a necessary change order to the professional service contract so that the projects are able to be
39 completed in a timely manner.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
44 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in
45 force at the earliest time provided by law.

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47 SECTION 4

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49 It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to
50 the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
51 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in
52 meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of
53 the Ohio Revised Code.
