7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with United Way of Summit County to provide homeless prevention services**
9 **through the Home Again Homeless Crisis Response Program, for a one-year term, from**
10 **10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, for the Executive's**
11 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 5, 2018, awarded a
14 professional service contract with United Way of Summit County, for homeless prevention
15 services through the Home Again Homeless Crisis Response Program, for a one-year term, from
16 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, subject to confirmation by
17 County Council; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that the aforementioned professional service contract with United Way of Summit County is
21 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with United Way of
29 Summit County to provide homeless prevention services through the Home Again Homeless
30 Crisis Response Program, for a one-year term, from 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in an amount not to
31 exceed \$200,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to
32 execute such professional service contract.

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
38 provide for homeless prevention services to Summit County residents through the Home Again
39 Homeless Crisis Response Program effective 10/1/18.

44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take


