7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept an award of a IDEP/STEP Traffic Enforcement Program grant from the Ohio**  
9 **Department of Public Safety, for the period 10/1/18 to 9/30/19, in the amount of \$79,600.05,**  
10 **with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating said grant funds, for the Sheriff,**  
11 **and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, County of Summit Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant, in the amount  
14 of \$79,600.05, with no local cash match requirement, from the Ohio Department of Public Safety  
15 ("ODPS"), through their Ohio Traffic Safety Office ("OTSO"), in order to operate a Traffic  
16 Enforcement Program ("IDEP/STEP") program in the County of Summit; and

18 WHEREAS, the IDEP/STEP grant has provided funding for the past 18 years to the  
19 Sheriff's Office for overtime work, in order to conduct selective traffic enforcement, public  
20 awareness, and education in the County of Summit; and

22 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
23 necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the  
24 aforementioned IDEP/STEP grant through OTSO, and to appropriate said grant funds;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
27 of Ohio, that:

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29 SECTION 1

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31 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
32 a grant award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for a IDEP/STEP Traffic Enforcement  
33 Program grant, for the period of 10/1/18 to 9/30/19, in the amount of \$76,600.05, with no local  
34 cash match requirement.



27 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


