7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the Innovative Response to Behavior in the Community: Swift, Certain, and Fair**
9 **Supervision FY2018 competitive grant from the United States Department of Justice’s**
10 **Office of Justice Program, for the Summit County Offender Recidivism Reduction project,**
11 **for the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/21, in the amount of \$599,978.00, with no local cash**
12 **match requirement, and appropriating said grant funds, for the County Court of Common**
13 **Pleas - Adult Probation, and declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice’s Office of Justice Program has
16 awarded the Innovative Response to Behavior in the Community: Swift, Certain, and Fair
17 Supervision FY2018 competitive grant to the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas - Adult
18 Probation for the Summit County Offender Recidivism Reduction (“SCORR”) project, in the
19 amount of \$599,978.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/18 through
20 9/30/21; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
24 Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award through the Department of
25 Justice’s Office of Justice Program, of the Innovative Response to Behavior in the Community:
26 Swift, Certain, and Fair Supervision FY2018 competitive grant in the amount of \$599,978.00, for
27 the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/21, with no local cash match requirement;

31 the acceptance of the Innovative Response to Behavior in the Community: Swift, Certain, and
32 Fair Supervision FY2018 competitive grant, and immediately appropriating said grant funds in
33 order to establish and provide services through the SCORR Project within the grant period.

47 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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


