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7 **A Resolution declaring the month of October 2018 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in**  
8 **Summit County, recognizing the many losses of family members and friends to breast**  
9 **cancer, celebrating our survivors and their courage, emphasizing the need for more early**  
10 **detection and finding a cure and encouraging the residents of Summit County to join in**  
11 **this acknowledgement by wearing pink on October 26, 2018, for the Council and the**  
12 **Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society reports breast cancer is the second largest  
15 cause of cancer deaths among women and one in eight women will be diagnosed with breast  
16 cancer in their lifetime; and

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18 WHEREAS, in 2018, it's estimated that there will be 2,550 new cases of invasive breast  
19 cancer diagnosed in men, with an estimated 480 deaths, and an estimated 266,120 new cases of  
20 invasive breast cancer diagnosed in women, with an estimated 40,920 deaths; and

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22 WHEREAS, due to early detection, through screening, increased awareness and  
23 treatment there are more than 3 million breast cancer survivors are in the U.S. alone; and

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25 WHEREAS, from investing in research, providing free rides to treatment, giving  
26 insurance advice and providing a free place to stay during chemotherapy, the American Cancer  
27 Society is attacking cancer from every angle; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
30 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that October 2018 be  
31 declared Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Summit County, and encouraging the residents of  
32 Summit County to join in this acknowledgement by wearing pink on October 26, 2018;

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34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
35 of Ohio, that:

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39 The month of October 2018 is hereby declared Breast Cancer Awareness Month in  
40 Summit County, and encouraging the residents of Summit County to join in this  
41 acknowledgement by wearing pink on October 26, 2018.
