7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept an award from the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services of a**  
9 **Federal Fiscal Year 2019 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Title XX grant to the**  
10 **Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for its Guardian Ad Litem services program, for**  
11 **the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in the amount of \$285,000.00, with no local cash match**  
12 **requirement, and appropriating funds, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division,**  
13 **and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services has  
16 awarded a Federal Fiscal Year 2019 ("FFY 2019") Temporary Assistance to Needy Families  
17 Title XX ("TANF") grant to the County of Summit, Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division  
18 for its Guardian Ad Litem services program, for the period 10/1/18 through 9/30/19, in the  
19 amount of \$285,000.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

21 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-304, which confirms  
22 an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with the County of Summit  
23 Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for Guardian Ad Litem services, for a one-year term,  
24 from 10/1/18 to 9/30/19, in an amount not to exceed \$285,000.00; and

26 WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2019 TANF  
27 grant from DJFS and to appropriate said grant funds; and

29 WHEREAS, additional Reclaim Ohio grant funds, in the amount of \$45,000.00, are  
30 available to supplement the FFY 2019 TANF grant funds; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
33 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
34 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned FFY 2019 TANF  
35 grant from DJFS and to appropriate grant funds, in a total amount of \$330,000.00;

37 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
38 of Ohio, that:

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42 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
43 an award from the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services of a Federal Fiscal Year  
44 2019 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Title XX grant to the Court of Common Pleas-  
45 Juvenile Division for its Guardian Ad Litem services program, for the period 10/1/18 through  
46 9/30/19, in the amount of \$285,000.00, with no local cash match requirement.

35 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
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
