7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement and any other**
8 **documents necessary for an inter-county transfer of funds between the Executive's**
9 **Department of Job and Family Services and Athens County Department of Job and Family**
10 **Services, pursuant to which agreement Summit County will transfer up to \$57,607.00 in**
11 **exchange for up to \$57,607.00 for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services,**
12 **and declaring an emergency.**

14 Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code authorizes counties to execute a
15 JFS 02719 "Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds" to
16 engage in inter-county transfers of funds allocated to county departments of job and family
17 services by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b) provides that a board of county
20 commissioners may assign authority to another party to serve as designee and therefore, grant
21 that party authority to sign an inter-county adjustment agreement on behalf of the county for a
22 specific period of time; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-214, which authorizes
25 the County Executive to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county Agreement and Certification
26 Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section
27 5101:9-6-82 for the acceptance by the County Executive's Department of Job and Family
28 Services ("SCDJFS") of inter-county transfers of funds from other Ohio counties, for the period
29 6/14/17 through 6/30/19, and assigns the County Executive as designee of the County of Summit
30 to execute said agreements and documents as provided in Section 5101:9-6-82(F)(2)(b), for the
31 period 6/14/17 through 6/30/19; and

33 WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the County of Athens wish to enter into an
34 agreement pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which SCDJFS will transfer \$37,607.00
35 in FFY18 Title XX Base federal dollars and up to \$20,000.00 in Comprehensive Case
36 Management Employment Program ("CCMEP") Regular dollars to the Athens County
37 Department of Job and Family Services ("Athens CDJFS"), in exchange for up to \$57,607.00 of
38 FFY18 Title XX Transfer funds, which will fund prior year TANF expenditures or be transferred
39 to Summit County Children's Services; and

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41 WHEREAS, while Resolution No. 2017-214 authorizes the Executive to accept the
42 transfer of funds to SCDJFS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute an agreement
43 and any other documents necessary for the inter-county transfer of up to \$57,607.00 to Athens
44 CDJFS; and

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46 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
47 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
48 Executive to execute the JFS 07219 Inter-county Agreement and Certification Release and
49 Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for
50 the transfer of up to \$57,607.00 in funds to Athens CDJFS;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the JFS 02719 Inter-county
10 Agreement and Certification Release and Acceptance of Funds, and any other documents
11 necessary pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 for the transfer by the Summit County Department of
12 Job and Family Services ("SCDJFS") of up to \$57,607.00 in FFY18 Title XX Base federal
13 dollars to the Athens County Department of Job and Family Services ("Athens CDJFS").

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15 SECTION 2

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17 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
18 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
19 authorize the transfer by SCDJS of said funds to Athens CDJFS.

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21 SECTION 3

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23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


