WHEREAS, the IT Board, at its December 6, 2018 meeting, authorized the County Executive to execute two professional service contracts and one purchase contract with BPI Information Systems, at less than State Term pricing, to upgrade the vcenter and e-mail systems at the Court of Common Pleas-General Division and to purchase information technology equipment for use by the Court, in a total amount not to exceed \$56,909.00; and

WHEREAS, the quote for the purchase contract has been reduced from \$41,909.00 to \$35,109.00, which has resulted in a new total amount not to exceed \$50,109.00;

WHEREAS the approval of the Board of Control is required; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, said professional service contracts and purchase contract with BPI Information Systems, in an amount not to exceed \$50,109.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
