WHEREAS Resolution No. 2019-332, as amended by Resolution No. 2019-361, authorizes the County Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding documents, in the Multi-District Litigation which are necessary to effectuate a resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to pay said law firms, fees and the costs of litigation in accordance with the agreement for representation, from the proceeds of current settlements and any future recovery by trial or settlement; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to pay the aforementioned fees and costs of litigation, in accordance with the agreement for representation, from the proceeds of current settlements and any future recovery by trial or settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to pay to pay fees and costs of litigation, in accordance with the agreement for representation, from the proceeds of current settlements and any future recovery by trial or settlement on its claims in the Multi-District Litigation, before Judge Dan Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio . The Executive is further authorized to execute any necessary documents to effectuate said payment.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize payment to be made to the law firms that represented the County in the Multi-District Litigation.
