A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC for food services at the Summit County Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/19 through 11/30/20, in a total amount not to exceed \$800,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-458, which confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC to provide food services at the Summit County Jail and Glenwood Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/15 through 11/30/16, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, in a total amount not to exceed \$700,000.00; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-360, which changed the designation of the Glenwood Jail to a Community Alternative Sentencing Center and as a result, relieved the County from the responsibility of providing food services to said facility; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 20, 2019, awarded a renewal (fourth and final) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC to provide food services at the Summit County Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/19 through 11/30/20, in a total amount not to exceed \$800,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, County Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the renewal of the aforementioned purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (fourth and final) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC for food services at the Summit County Jail, for a one-year term, from 12/1/19 through 11/30/20, in a total amount not to exceed \$800,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further reason to immediately provide for food services at the Summit County Jail.
