A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a grant agreement and any other documents necessary to accept an award by the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health of grant funds for lead abatement for the period 12/1/19 through 7/31/24, in the amount of \$3,621,543.81, with no local cash match requirement, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") Office of Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control is authorized to administer a Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program ("LHRDGP") under Section 1011 of the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health ("SCPH") has received Lead Based Paint Hazard Control ("LBPHC") and Healthy Homes Intervention ("HHI") program grant funding from HUD to provide lead hazard reduction rehabilitation services in partnership with the County of Summit in areas which are occupied by low income families with children under the age of six and where lead-based paint hazards have been found and require remediation in order to provide the opportunity for residents to live and raise a family in a safe environment; and

WHEREAS, SCPH has awarded the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development LBPHC and HHI grant funds for the period 12/1/19 through 7/31/24, in the amount of \$3,621,543.81, with no local cash match requirement, for the County of Summit, through the Department of Community and Economic Development, to be engaged as service provider to implement the objective of lead paint abatement in units meeting the income qualifications in areas of Summit County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute a grant agreement and any other documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant funds from SCPH;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents necessary to accept an award by the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit Public Health ("SCPH") of Lead Based Paint Hazard Control ("LBPHC") and Healthy Homes Intervention ("HHI") program grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control for the County of Summit, through the Department of Community and Economic Development, to be engaged as a service provider for lead abatement in areas of Summit County, for the period 12/1/19 through 7/31/24, in the amount of \$3,621,543.81, with no local cash match requirement.

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SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the acceptance of the award by SCPH of LBPHC and HHI program grant funds so that lead abatement projects in Summit County may commence effective 12/1/19.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
