An Ordinance amending Section 923.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Billing," to incorporate industrial pretreatment charges, administrative fines and fees into the Section so that the fees can be charged, and certified, in accordance with the Section's billing and collection procedures, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 923.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitled "Billing," currently authorizes the County to bill property owners for user charges, and certify delinquent charges with the County Auditor, but does not expressly authorize industrial pretreatment charges, administrative fines and fees ("Industrial Fees") to be administrated in the same fashion; and

WHEREAS, Section 6117.02(C)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes sanitary sewer districts to bill property owners for all unpaid charges associated with connecting to the sewer, sewage treatment, or disposal works, and certifying said charges with the county auditor; and

WHEREAS, said charges are certified with the County Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 6117.02(C)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code, the County Executive proposes amending Section 923.04 to include Industrial Fees within the Section to harmonize the County's billing and collection procedures; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Section 923.04 of the Codified Ordinances for the aforementioned reasons:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Section 923.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Billing," is hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately amend Section 923.04 of the Codified Ordinances to unite the user charges, surcharges, industrial pretreatment charges, and administrative fines and fees, billing and collection procedures.
