A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Tuberculosis Funding Agreement with the Ohio Department of Health, to accept a grant to offset the cost of public health activities associated with tuberculosis patients, for the period 7/1/19 through 12/31/19, in the amount of \$43,236.00, with no local cash match requirement, authorizing the Executive to execute any additional necessary documents related to said grant, appropriating said grant funds, and authorizing the payment of said grant funds to the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health ("ODH") has awarded the County of Summit a grant to offset the cost of public health activities associated with the reporting, investigation, and case management of tuberculosis patients that complete an approved course of treatment, for the period 7/1/19 through 12/31/19, in the amount of \$43,236.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-375, which designated the Communicable Disease Unit operated by the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health as the Summit County Tuberculosis Control Unit, as required by Section 339.72 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, in order to accept the aforementioned grant, it is necessary for the County Executive to execute a Tuberculosis Funding Agreement (the "Agreement") with the ODH; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the Executive to execute any additional necessary documents related to said grant; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate said grant funds; and

WHEREAS, it is further necessary to authorize the payment of said grant funds to the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health as the Summit County Tuberculosis Control Unit; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the Agreement, to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the ODH, to authorize the Executive to execute any additional necessary documents related to said grant, to appropriate grant funds and to authorize the payment of said funds from said grant to the Summit County Combined General Health District d.b.a. Summit County Public Health;
