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7 **A Resolution approving the assignment to AllOne Health of a professional service contract**
8 **with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance**
9 **Program ("EAP) services for County employees and employees of other participating**
10 **political subdivisions, for a one-year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not**
11 **to exceed \$123,452.00, authorizing that said assignment shall apply to the two renewals of**
12 **said contract, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a consent to assignment and**
13 **any other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract, for the**
14 **Executive's Department of Human Resources-Employee Benefits Division, and declaring**
15 **an emergency.**

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17 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-321, which
18 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with The Centers
19 for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP) services
20 for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, for a one-year
21 term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term,
22 for an amount not to exceed \$18.30 per employee per year, for a total amount not to exceed
23 \$123,452.00; and

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25 WHEREAS, The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work was acquired by
26 AllOne Health effective 8/1/19; and

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28 WHEREAS, Section 15f. of the contract with The Centers for Families and Children
29 d.b.a. Ease@Work requires the consent of the County to assign the contract to AllOne Health;
30 and

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32 WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to approve the assignment by The Centers for
33 Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of said professional service contract
34 between the County and The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for EAP
35 services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, to
36 authorize that said assignment shall apply to the two renewals of said contract, and to authorize
37 the Executive to execute a consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve
38 said assignment of the contract to AllOne Health; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the assignment by The
42 Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of the professional
43 service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a.
44 Ease@Work for EAP services for County employees and employees of other participating
45 political subdivisions, to authorize that said assignment shall apply to the two renewals of said
46 contract, and to authorize the County Executive to execute a consent to assignment and any other
47 necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract to AllOne Health;

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49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
50 of Ohio, that:

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The assignment by The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne
7 Health of the professional service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and
8 Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP) services for County
9 employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions is hereby approved. The
10 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a consent to assignment and any other
11 necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract. The approval of the assignment
12 by The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of the
13 professional service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and Children
14 d.b.a. Ease@Work, shall apply to both the professional service contract with The Centers for
15 Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for the period of 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, for an
16 amount not to exceed \$18.30 per employee per year, for a total amount not to exceed
17 \$123,452.00, and to the two renewals of said contract approved by Resolution No. 2018-321.

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19 SECTION 2

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21 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
22 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will
23 immediately approve the assignment to AllOne Health of a professional service contract with
24 The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work so that AllOne Health can
25 immediately continue to provide necessary EAP Services for County employees and employees
26 of other participating political subdivisions.

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28 SECTION 3

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30 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
31 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
32 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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34 SECTION 4

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36 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
37 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
38 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
39 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
40 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


