DECOLUTION NO

 A Resolution approving the assignment to AllOne Health of a professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP) services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, for a one-year term, from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$123,452.00, authorizing that said assignment shall apply to the two renewals of said contract, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract, for the Executive's Department of Human Resources-Employee Benefits Division, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-321, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP) services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, for a one-year term, from 1/l/19 through 12/31/19, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, for an amount not to exceed \$18.30 per employee per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$123,452.00; and

WHEREAS, The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work was acquired by AllOne Health effective 8/1/19; and

WHEREAS, Section 15f. of the contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work requires the consent of the County to assign the contract to AllOne Health; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to approve the assignment by The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of said professional service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for EAP services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, to authorize that said assignment shall apply to the two renewals of said contract, and to authorize the Executive to execute a consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract to AllOne Health; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the assignment by The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of the professional service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for EAP services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions, to authorize that said assignment shall apply to the two renewals of said contract, and to authorize the County Executive to execute a consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract to AllOne Health;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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The assignment by The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of the professional service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for Employee Assistance Program ("EAP) services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions is hereby approved. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a consent to assignment and any other necessary documents to approve said assignment of the contract. The approval of the assignment by The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work to AllOne Health of the professional service contract between the County and The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work, shall apply to both the professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work for the period of 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, for an amount not to exceed \$18.30 per employee per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$123,452.00, and to the two renewals of said contract approved by Resolution No. 2018-321.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately approve the assignment to AllOne Health of a professional service contract with The Centers for Families and Children d.b.a. Ease@Work so that AllOne Health can immediately continue to provide necessary EAP Services for County employees and employees of other participating political subdivisions.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
