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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Ganley Ford, Inc. for the purchase of six Ford Explorer police interceptor models, at less**
9 **than CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$194,857.20, for the Sheriff, and declaring**
10 **an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held July 24, 2019, awarded a purchase
13 contract to Ganley Ford, Inc. for the purchase of six Ford Explorer police interceptor models, at
14 less than CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$194,857.20, subject to confirmation by
15 County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
21 of Ohio, that:

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23 SECTION 1

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25 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract to Ganley Ford, Inc. for the
26 purchase of six Ford Explorer police interceptor models, at less than CUE pricing, in an amount
27 not to exceed \$194,857.20, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized
28 to execute such contract.

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30 SECTION 2

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32 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
33 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
34 provide for necessary law enforcement vehicles for the Sheriff.

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36 SECTION 3

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38 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
39 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
40 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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42 SECTION 4

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44 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
45 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
47 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
48 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


