- 1) Examine and recommend practices, policies and legislation that will ensure environmentally sustainable and energy-efficient construction, improvement, repair, management and operation of County-owned facilities.
- 2) Examine and recommend practices, policies and legislation to ensure a more fuel-efficient County vehicle fleet.
- 3) Examine and recommend practices, policies and legislation that will ensure a more sustainable and environmentally sustainable food system in Summit County, both for the County's operational benefit and the benefit of the community at-large.
- 4) Examine and recommend practices, policies and legislation whereby the County can take reasonable measures for the purpose of environmental protection and environmental sustainability in the interest of preserving and improving the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Summit County, while preserving economic growth in Summit County.
- 5) Examine and recommend practices and policies that promote and improve awareness, participation and environmental literacy throughout Summit County.
- 6) Examine and recommend plans for the County that would encourage the twin goals of environmental protection and economic growth, meeting today's needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.
- Examine and recommend any practices, policies and legislation that further the County's commitment to environmental sustainability, energy-efficiency and environmental protection.
- 8) In examining these areas, the Task Force is encouraged to look at best practices of other local governments in the State of Ohio and beyond.

## **SECTION 3**

The membership of the Task Force shall consist of the following members which shall be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by this Council.

- 1) Two Summit County Council members or designees
- 2) Director of the County Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services or designee
- 3) Director of the County Executive's Department of Administrative Services or designee
- 4) Summit County Engineer or designee
- 5) Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation dba Summit County Land Bank
- 6) Soil and Water Conservation District
- 7) Summit Akron Solid waste Authority dba Reworks
- 8) Summit County Metro Parks
- 9) Ohio EPA
- 10) A representative of the City of Akron
- 11) A Township Trustee of a Township within Summit County
- 12) A Mayor of a City of Village in the County other than the City of Akron

### **SECTION 4**

Following the appointment and confirmation of its members, the task Force will deliberate for a six (6) month period and make a full written report to Council and the Executive setting forth its recommendations at the end of the period.

#### **SECTION 5**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose to provide a task force to address the improvements necessary to encourage environmentally sustainability in Summit County.

#### SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by the law

## **SECTION 7**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
