7 **A Resolution approving salary adjustments for classified non-bargaining Part-Time**

9 **the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, the County Sheriff wishes to grant salary adjustments for classified non-
12 bargaining Part-Time Intermittent Deputies Christopher Bickett, John Sim and Daniel Sladek
13 effective 7/1/19; and

15 WHEREAS, because the salary adjustments for the aforementioned employees represent
16 pay increases under Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, County
17 Council's approval of the salary adjustments is required; and

19 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Human Resources will review the
20 personnel action for the aforementioned salary adjustment as required by Section 169.07(b) of
21 the Codified Ordinances; and

23 WHEREAS, the salary adjustment will be submitted to the Director of the Department of
24 Finance and Budget for certification of availability of appropriated funds, as required by Section
25 169.07(b) of the Codified Ordinances; and

27 WHEREAS, that the hourly rate for full time deputies is \$29.57 hourly, and the proposed
28 new rates of pay remain below that level; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
31 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve and authorize the
32 Sheriff to make the aforementioned salary adjustments effective 7/1/19;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

40 necessary for the effective and continued operation of his office to approve the following salary

43 the availability of funds from the Director of the Department of Finance and Budget:


