RESOLUTION NO. 2019-231

A Resolution submitting to the electors of the County of Summit at the November 5, 2019 general election a proposed charter amendment, as recommended by the 2018-2019 Charter Review Commission, to amend Article VI, Sections 6.02 and 6.05 to create an Equal Employment Opportunity Administrator under the authority of the Human Resource Commission, for the Charter Review Commission, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 3, Article X of the Ohio Constitution provides that "[t]he people of any county may frame and adopt . . . a charter . . .;" and

WHEREAS, the voters of the County of Summit approved the adoption of the County Charter on November 6, 1979; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 5.06 of the County Charter provides that "[p]roposed amendments to [the] Charter shall be submitted to the electors of the County by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of the County Council...;" and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 5.03 of the Charter provides for a nine member Charter Review Commission to meet in September 2003 and every five years thereafter to review the Charter and make recommendations concerning the amendment of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Motion 032-2018, which confirmed the appointments of Mr. James Armstrong, Ms. Helen J. Humphrys, Mr. Cazzell Smith, Sr., Ms. Laura Wallerstein, Ms. Lisa Miller, Mr. Omar Banks, Ms. Sylvia Trundle, Mr. Charley Sollie and Mr. Jeff Snell to the 2018-2019 Charter Review Commission; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Motion 004-2019, which confirmed the appointment of Ms. Katherine Procop to replace Mr. Charles Sollie on the 2018-2019 Charter Review Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission met from October 19, 2018, through May 21, 2019, and produced a Final Report recommending two amendments to the Charter, including the amendment that is proposed by this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, in its Final Report, submitted to this Council on June 3, 2019, the Charter Review Commission recommends the amendment of the Charter to create an Equal Employment Opportunity Administrator under the authority of the Human Resource Commission; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to adopt the Commission's recommendation and that the citizens of the County should be permitted to decide at the November 5, 2019 general election whether to amend the Charter to create an Equal Employment Opportunity Administrator under the authority of the Human Resource Commission;

- (1) Responsibility for the resolution or disposition of all personnel matters, with authority to appoint hearing officers to hear all employee appeals previously under the jurisdiction of the State Personnel Board of Review;
- (2) Responsibility for administration of county-wide compliance with federal and state laws regarding personnel matters for which the County is the reporting unit and for administration of other personnel matters for which the County is responsible, and for maintenance of records required by such laws. For purposes of ensuring consistent compliance with state and Federal Equal Employment Opportunity laws and regulations, the Commission shall employ an Equal Opportunity Compliance Administrator as part of the staff of the Commission;
 - (3) Authority to ensure:
 pay equity for like positions;
 standardization of benefits;
 approval of qualifications;
 consistent discipline;
 training of management in personnel practices;
 training of employees in job functions;
 training for total quality management;
 consistent administration of performance management system;
 coordination of recruitment;
 - compliance to ethics resolutions or ordinances as passed by County Council; and Such other functions as may be necessary to carry out its mission and purpose.

Unless otherwise specified above, the responsibilities and authorities set forth in this Subsection 6.05 may be performed by the Department of Human Resources and the staff of the Department of Human Resources, as the Human Resource Commission shall prescribe, pursuant to Subsection 6.02 above."

SECTION 4

The Clerk of Council shall certify the question set forth herein to the Board of Elections of the County of Summit no later than the ninetieth day prior to the General Election of November 5, 2019.

SECTION 5

Notice of the proposed amendment set forth herein shall be given by the Clerk of Council by publishing the full text of the proposed amendment once a week for at least two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published in the County as set forth in Section 307.70 of the Ohio Revised Code.
