DECOLUTION NO

A Resolution appropriating an award from the State of Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, through the Community Based Correctional Facility subsidy grant program for State Fiscal Years 2020-2021, the period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$11,104,912.00, with no local cash match requirement, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a two-year renewal agreement with Oriana House, Inc. and the Summit County Facility Governing Board, for the operation of the County of Summit's Community Based Correctional Facility, for an amount not to exceed \$11,104,912.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction ("ODRC"), through the Community Based Correctional Facility ("CBCF") subsidy grant program, has awarded to the County of Summit a grant for the operation of a community based correctional facility for State Fiscal Years 2020-2021, the period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$11,104,912.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Facility Governing Board, as the grant's statutory oversight committee, has accepted this funding and selected Oriana House, Inc., as the vendor to continue the management of the County of Summit's Community Based Correctional Facility's operations; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit will continue to serve as the fiscal agent for the grant program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate said CBCF grant funds from the ODRC, in the amount of \$11,104,912.00; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County to enter into a two-year renewal grant agreement with Oriana House, Inc. and the Summit County Facility Governing Board for the operation of the County of Summit's Community Based Correctional Facility for State Fiscal Years 2020-2021, the period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$11,104,912.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that is it necessary and in the best interest of the County to appropriate the CBCF subsidy grant funds and to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned two-year renewal agreement with Oriana House, Inc. and the Summit County Facility Governing Board for the operation of the County of Summit's Community Based Correctional Facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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SECTION 1

Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

SECTION 2

The County Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to effect the within appropriations.

SECTION 3

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a two-year renewal agreement with Oriana House, Inc. and the Summit County Facility Governing Board for the operation of the County of Summit's Community Based Correctional Facility for State Fiscal Years 2020-2021, the period 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$11,104,912.00.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately appropriating grant funds for the operation of the County of Summit's Community Based Correctional Facility in order to be able to properly expend them within the grant period, beginning 7/1/19.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
