A Resolution declaring a break in the Tallmadge siphon line under the CSX rail line located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council Districts 3 and 6, to be an emergency, and confirming an award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. for an emergency repair to the Tallmadge siphon line under the CSX rail line, in an amount not to exceed \$403,196.01, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, due to a break in the sanitary sewer siphon under the CSX rail line located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council Districts 3 and 6, it was necessary for the County to utilize HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. for an emergency repair of the siphon line; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit permits the County Executive to enter into agreements without following the competitive bidding process in times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, this Council hereby determines that the repair of the sanitary sewer siphon under the CSX rail line by HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. to be an emergency repair pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on May 29, 2019, awarded a construction contract with HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. for an emergency repair to the Tallmadge siphon line under the CSX rail line, in the amount of \$403,196.01, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned repair constitutes an emergency repair under Section 177.07(a)(3) and further finds and determines that the aforementioned construction contract with HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

This Council finds and determines that the repair of the Tallmadge siphon line under the CSX rail line located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council Districts 3 and 6, by HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. to be an emergency repair pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

SECTION 2

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with HM Miller Construction Co., Inc. for an emergency repair to the Tallmadge siphon line under the CSX rail line located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council Districts 3 and 6, in an amount not to exceed \$403,196.01, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is authorized to execute such construction contract and any other necessary documents.

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SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately declare the repair to the Tallmadge siphon line to be an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) and authorize a necessary construction contract for said repair.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
