9 **A Resolution declaring the week of April 22-26, 2019 as National Community Development**
10 **Week in the County of Summit and encouraging the residents of Summit County to join in**
11 **this acknowledgment, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the week of April 22-26, 2019 has been designated as National Community
14 Development Week ("CD Week") to recognize and celebrate the U.S. Department of Housing
15 and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program and the
16 HOME Investment Partnerships ("HOME") Program; and

17
18 WHEREAS, since 1975, the CDBG Program has provided annual funding and flexibility
19 to local communities to provide affordable housing, a suitable living environment, and economic
20 opportunities; and

21
22 WHEREAS, since, 1992, the HOME Program has created and preserved affordable
23 housing for low-income families; and

24
25 WHEREAS, CD Week was created in 1986 to bring national attention to the CDBG
26 Program which was facing scrutiny by Congress at the time, and later expanded to include the
27 HOME Program; and

29 WHEREAS, CD Week, held annually during the Congressional appropriations season,
30 recognizes the importance of the CDBG and HOME programs, highlighting these programs'
31 accomplishments and community benefits through local events and meetings with members of
32 Congress; and

34 WHEREAS, over the past five years, our community has received more than
35 \$4,600,000.00 in CDBG funds and \$1,380,000.00 in HOME funds; and

37 WHEREAS, both programs have suffered funding cuts over the years, making it
38 imperative to bring national attention to both the CDBG and HOME programs, and specifically
39 the need for increased program funding; and

41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
42 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare the week of April
43 22-26, 2019 National Community Development week in the County of Summit and encouraging
44 the residents of Summit County to join in this acknowledgment;

46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
47 of Ohio, that:

18 SECTION 3



30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


