A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain providers for Summer Youth Employment Program monitoring services, work readiness skills training, and other additional services, for the period 5/1/19 through 9/30/19, in a total amount not to exceed \$193,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 27, 2019, awarded professional service contracts with certain providers, per attached Exhibit A, for Summer Youth Employment Program ("SYEP") monitoring services, work readiness skills training, and other additional services, for the period 5/1/19 through 9/30/19, in a total amount not to exceed \$193,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned professional service contracts for SYEP monitoring services are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain providers, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated, for Summer Youth Employment Program ("SYEP") monitoring services, work readiness skills training, and other additional services, for the period 5/1/19 through 9/30/19, in a total amount not to exceed \$193,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contracts.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for SYEP monitoring services, work readiness skills training and other additional services effective 5/1/19.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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
