7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of professional service**
8 **contracts with certain providers for Summer Youth Employment Program monitoring**
9 **services, work readiness skills training, and other additional services, for the period 5/1/19**
10 **through 9/30/19, in a total amount not to exceed \$193,000.00, for the Executive's**
11 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 27, 2019, awarded
14 professional service contracts with certain providers, per attached Exhibit A, for Summer Youth
15 Employment Program ("SYEP") monitoring services, work readiness skills training, and other
16 additional services, for the period 5/1/19 through 9/30/19, in a total amount not to exceed
17 \$193,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that the aforementioned professional service contracts for SYEP monitoring services are
21 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
24 of Ohio, that:

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26 SECTION 1

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28 The award by the Board of Control of professional service contracts with certain
29 providers, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated,
30 for Summer Youth Employment Program ("SYEP") monitoring services, work readiness skills
31 training, and other additional services, for the period 5/1/19 through 9/30/19, in a total amount
32 not to exceed \$193,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized
33 to execute such professional service contracts.

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 provide for SYEP monitoring services, work readiness skills training and other additional
40 services effective 5/1/19.

45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
