A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with RJ Beck Protective Systems, Inc., at GSA pricing, for the purchase of an alarm system for the City of Green Local School District, in an amount not to exceed \$145,028.27, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 27, 2019, awarded a purchase contract with RJ Beck Protective Systems, Inc., as GSA pricing, for the purchase of an alarm system for the City of Green Local School District, in an amount not to exceed \$145,028.27, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, said purchase will be funded by a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services School Violence Prevention Program Grant previously accepted by the County pursuant to Resolution No. 2018-457; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with RJ Beck Protective Systems, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with RJ Beck Protective Systems, Inc., at GSA pricing, for the purchase of an alarm system for the City of Green Local School District, in an amount not to exceed \$145,028.27, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the purchase of a necessary alarm system for the safety of students and teachers in the City of Green School District.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
