A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the installation of one new aboveground diesel fuel tank and dispensing system and the removal of the underground diesel tank at the Engineer's E. South Street facility, located in the City of Akron, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$105,000.00 for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Engineer's Office needs a new aboveground diesel fuel dispenser for fueling diesel vehicles at the E. South Street facility, and to remove the current underground diesel tank at said facility, which requires annual permitting and testing to ensure no diesel is leaking into the ground water; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer estimates the total cost for labor and materials for the installation of the new tank and dispensing system and the removal of the current tank to be \$105,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to advertise for bids for the installation of a new aboveground diesel fuel dispenser and the removal of the current underground diesel tank at the Engineer's E. South Street facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for the installation of a new aboveground diesel fuel tank and dispensing system and the removal of the current underground diesel tank, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, with an estimated cost not to exceed \$105,000.00.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately create a safer, more environmentally friendly method of dispensing fuel to County-owned vehicles.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
