RESOLUTION NO. 2019-117

A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for the receipt of Title IV-E funds by the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for State Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021, the period from 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount estimated between \$750,000.00 and \$950,000.00 annually, with no local cash match requirement, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division is a subrecipient and subgrantee of funds to administer programs under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act ("Title IV-E funds"), with the State of Ohio serving as the grantee and recipient of said funds from the federal government; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division receiving Title IV-E funds, the State of Ohio has requested that the County enter into a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS"), setting forth the rights and responsibilities of each party as they pertain to the receipt of Title IV-E funds, for State Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021, the period from 7/1/19 through 6/30/21; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Division receives between \$750,000.00 and \$950,000.00 annually, with no local cash match requirement, with 25% going directly to the County General Fund and the rest supporting Court salaries and programs that help those youth who are at risk from being removed from the home; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute said subgrant agreement with ODJFS for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for the receipt of Title IV-E funds by the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division for State Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021, the period from 7/1/19 through 6/30/21, in an amount estimated between \$750,000.00 and \$950,000.00 annually, with no local cash match requirement.
