7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency**
8 **agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for the**
9 **Riverview Road Over Furnace Run Replacement Project, located in Cuyahoga Falls, in**
10 **Council District 3, for an estimated total construction cost not to exceed \$1,586,000.00, with**
11 **the Department of Transportation providing County Engineer's Association of Ohio Local**
12 **Bridge Program funds of up to \$1,499,120.00 to cover up to 80% of the project costs, with**
13 **the County Engineer being responsible for the balance of the project costs, for the**
14 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the replacement of the Riverview Road Bridge over Furnace Run, located in
17 Cuyahoga Falls, in Council District 3, is necessary and said project has been identified by the
18 County Engineer's Office as Project Identification Number 105067 (herein after referred to as
19 the "Project"); and

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21 WHEREAS, the estimated total construction cost of the Project is \$1,586,000.00; and

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23 WHEREAS, County Engineer's Association of Ohio Local Bridge Program funds have
24 been awarded to the County Engineer's office for a grant to cover up to 80% of the Project costs,
25 in an amount not to exceed \$1,499,120.00, with the County Engineer's Office being responsible
26 to provide the remaining funds necessary for the Project costs; and

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28 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation
29 ("ODOT"), and the County Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA")
30 agreement, to confirm the Project's costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead
31 agency for administration of the Project; and

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33 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(D) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
34 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA
35 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

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37 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will provide (i) that the estimated cost of the Project is
38 \$1,586,000.00, (ii) that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA up to 80% of eligible
39 Project costs, in an amount not to exceed \$1,499,120.00 in County Engineer's Association of
40 Ohio Local Bridge Program funds, and (iii) that the County, as the LPA, will provide the
41 remaining funds necessary to pay for the Project costs; and

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43 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it
44 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive
45 to execute the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT;

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47 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

4 SECTION 1

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6 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Local Public Agency ("LPA")
7 agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the
8 Riverview Road Bridge Over Furnace Run Replacement Project, Project Identification Number
9 105067 (the "Project") located in Cuyahoga Falls, in Council District 3, a copy of which is
10 attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions
11 as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said LPA agreement and not substantially adverse
12 to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the
13 County Executive. Upon federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the
14 administration of the Project, with the award of the Project subject to applicable Codified
15 Ordinances of the County of Summit, said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award
16 by the Board of Control and/or County Council.

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18 SECTION 2

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20 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
21 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
22 completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

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24 SECTION 3

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26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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30 SECTION 4

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32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
33 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
35 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
