WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution 2017-095, which authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of a Safety and Justice Challenge Grant from the MacArthur Foundation, for the period 1/1/17 through 6/30/18, in the amount of \$50,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriated the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the MacArthur Safety and Justice Grant awarded to the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety was used to design and test innovative local justice reforms to safely drive down jail usage and reduce racial and ethnic disparities in the local justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Public Safety, the County Sheriff and City of Akron have participated as partner agencies in order to develop a felony summons initiative which has successfully diverted low level, non-violent felony offenders who were otherwise eligible for a personal recognizance bond, from being housed in the County jail; and

WHEREAS, due to the success of the Felony Summons Program, the MacArthur Foundation has awarded the Division of Public Safety an additional Safety and Justice Challenge Capstone Grant to assist in enhancing current programs to improve jail usage and diversion, for the period 1/1/19 through 6/30/19, in the amount of \$20,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant, and to appropriate these grant funds;
